In addition, sports events such as the annual Penang Bridge International Marathon is popular around the glob among marathoners and sports enthusiasts.

However, with the recent Covid-19 pandemic, many have decided to opt for a virtual/ hybrid platform to showcase these festivals and celebrations. Meanwhile, all physical events will adhere to the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) set by the government.

Whether you are drawn to the drama of a street parade, the spirituality of a prayer ritual, the beauty of an avant-garde theatre performance, or the thrills of running on the state's iconic bridge, there is bound to be an event around the corner waiting to be experienced, physically or virtually.




