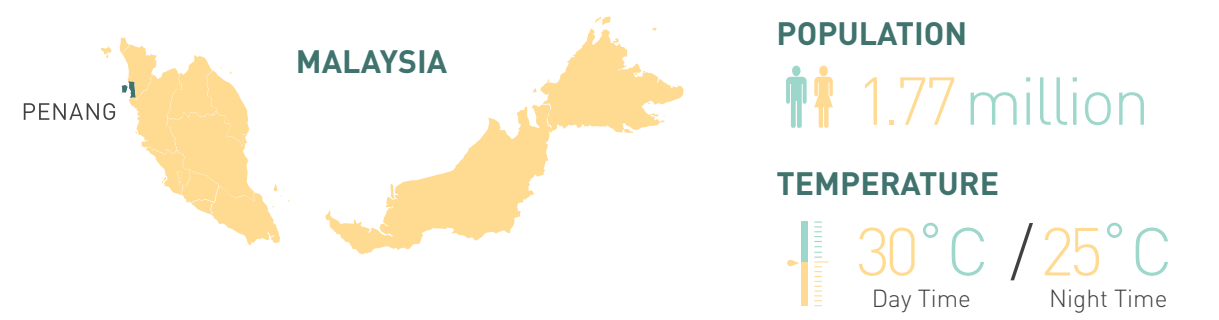

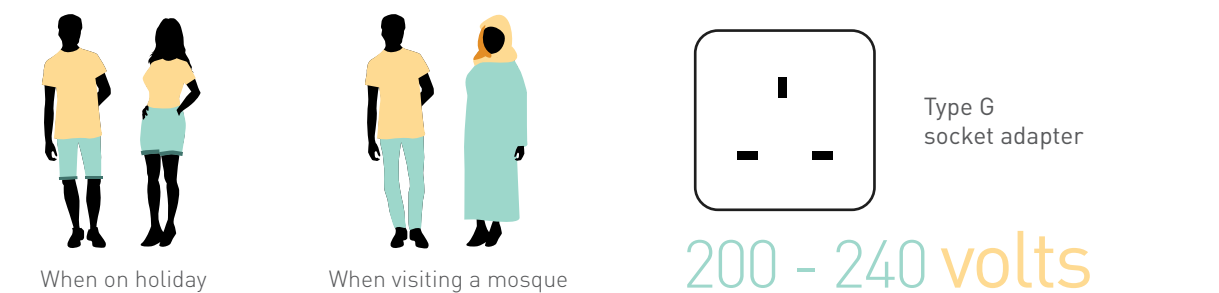

LOCATION

Penang Island is a 20-minute ferry ride from Butterworth. Two bridges connect the island to the mainland: Penang Bridge and the Second Penang Bridge (Jambatan Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah). Penang International Airport sees incoming international flights from many countries such as China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Taiwan, Vietnam and Qatar.

Langkawi Island is a 2 hours 45 minute ferry ride away, or a short 35-minute flight. Malaysia's capital Kuala Lumpur is a 50-minute flight away, or can alternatively be reached by a four-hour train or car ride.



LANGUAGE

Most signs are written in Malay and English, with some in Chinese as well. Although English is widely spoken in many areas, it would be helpful to know basic Malay too, as road signs and main destinations are in Malay.

TELECOMMUNICATION

A local SIM card can be purchased upon arrival at the airport. Simply choose from the different choices of telecommunication operators available. The retail stands are located at the arrival hall, after you exit from the baggage claim area. Most convenience shops offer credit top-up services when your SIM card credit runs out.

WI-FI

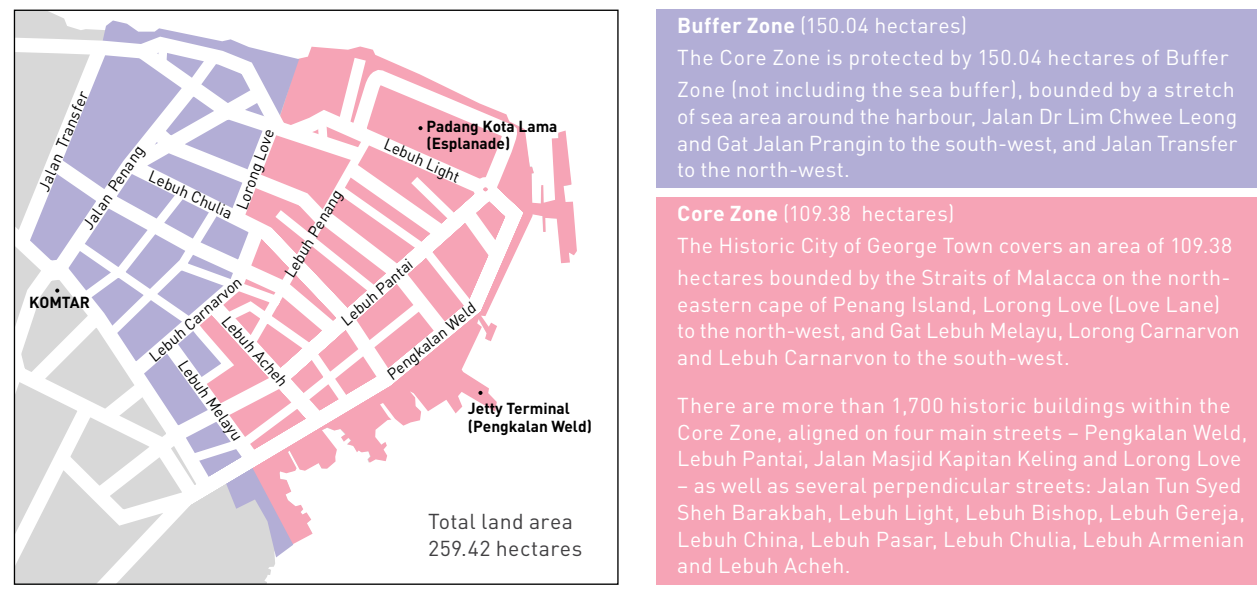
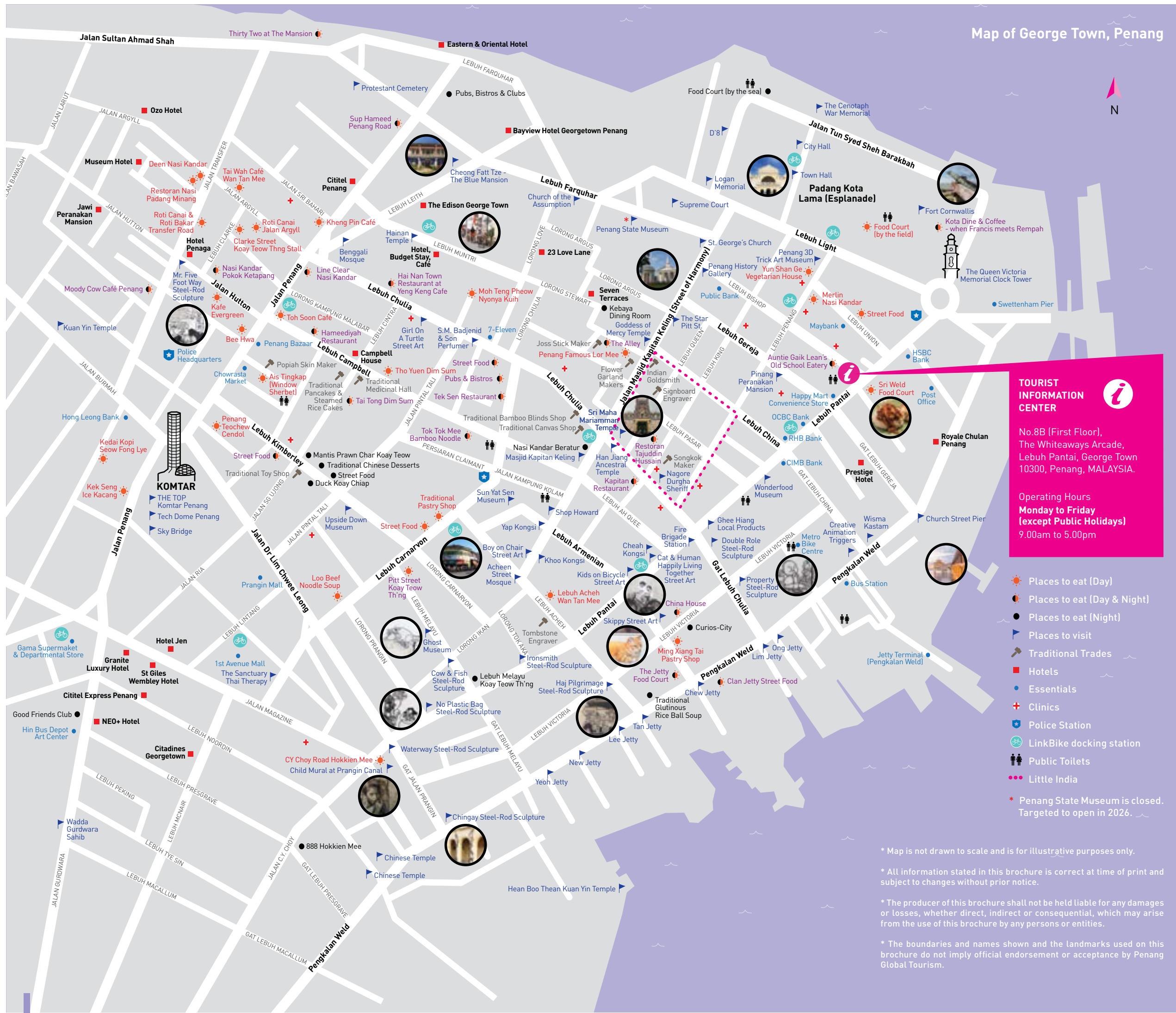
Penang has Wi-Fi networks befitting a tourist-friendly city. Wi-Fi is provided at the majority of the hotels and is available in most areas of the city.

There are 1,550 Wi-Fi spots at tourist attractions and public places throughout George Town. Most cafes also offer free Wi-Fi. For convenience, you may purchase a local SIM card with a data package to access the internet at all times.

CURRENCY

The Malaysian currency is the Ringgit, written as RM. There are six denominations: RM1, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100.

CRUISE TOURISM

The Swettenham Pier Cruise Terminal is Penang Port's latest and most significant addition after a major rebuild in 2010. The new pier accommodates Quantulclass cruise ships with the main berth capable of handling larger cruise vessels. Among the huge liners that have called at the port are Quantum of The Seas and Ovation of The Seas by the Royal Caribbean Cruisers, and the luxury liner Queen Elizabeth.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Downtown Penang is small enough in size for walking around, especially George Town and its surroundings. One can take in the sights in a trishaw or on a Link Bike. Alternatively, a free shuttle bus service, the Central Area Transit (CAT) bus, provides a convenient way of moving around town.

To get to attractions outside George Town – such as Kek Lok Si Temple, Penang Hill, Batu Ferringhi and Teluk Bahang – standard city buses and taxis are available, including e-hailing services. Always check schedules and fares before deciding on your preferred mode of transportation. Alternatively, you can also rent a car so you can get around at your own convenience.

Trishaw

A great and breezy way of getting around George Town is by trishaw. Be sure to agree on a price before starting your journey – the average rate is RM50 per hour for two persons, depending on the distance between the start and end points.

Ferry

There are two types of ferry services: fast ferries (for pedestrians only) and vehicle ferries (for motorcycles and bicycles). The air-conditioned fast ferries serve the Pengkalan Sultan Abdul Halim (Butterworth) to Swettenham Pier Cruise Terminal (George Town) route while the vehicle ferries serve the Pengkalan Sultan Abdul Halim (Butterworth) to Pengkalan Raja Tun Uda (George Town) route. If you are taking a train to Penang from Kuala Lumpur or other cities, you may board the ferry to the island from Pengkalan Sultan Abdul Halim at Butterworth, located just next to the train station.

Public Bus

The state's public bus service is provided by Rapid Penang and covers an extensive area, both on the island and mainland. It also offers a free Central Area Transit (CAT) bus service within George Town. The terminal at KOMTAR is the central transfer terminal for buses that ply the whole of Penang Island. Simply ask around or look out for signboards to find out which bus routes serve you best. Upon boarding the Rapid Penang bus, inform the driver of your destination, pay the amount required in cash and receive a ticket for your trip. Remember to prepare the exact change as all buses do not carry change for safety reasons.

Taxi

Taxis are commonly available around the island. It is an easy means of getting around by visitors. Be sure to agree on a price before boarding the taxi. Start by asking how much it is to get to your destination; you can negotiate on the pricing if you feel that it is too high.

Average Fare

From George Town to Penang International Airport: RM45
From George Town to Penang Hill or Kek Lok Si: RM30

E-Hailing Services

Ridesharing apps such as Grab and AirAsia Ride are available in Penang. Simply download the apps to start booking your trips. Payment is either by cash or credit card.

Car Rental Services

Renting a car offers great flexibility and convenience. Rental rate is charged on a daily basis. Just pay a deposit, and you are free to go anywhere on your own! Car rentals are available at the airport and around town. Most hotels can hook you up with one, too.

LinkBike

Link Bike is a bike-sharing system that allows users to pick up a bicycle at any of the 25 self-serve bike stations strategically located on the island and return it to any bike station at their convenience. Download the app and scan the QR code to release the bicycle. Users also can use the LinkBike Card instead of downloading the mobile app to use the service.

Public Bus

The state's public bus service is provided by Rapid Penang and covers an extensive area, both on the island and mainland. It also offers a free Central Area Transit (CAT) bus service within George Town. The terminal at KOMTAR is the central transfer terminal for buses that ply the whole of Penang Island. Free CAT Bus Route (George Town)

This is a free shuttle bus service that operates within George Town. It is the most common means of transportation for travelers to get around the city and to get to popular local attractions for free. Look out for Rapid Penang buses that bear a "Free CAT Bus" sign.
